Entry to service at any point during year

Baseline using PASS survey, Maths & English assessment. Any available recent prior data is considered

PERIOD of Induction into service to instil service expectations and readiness to benefit from learning-up to 1 week

On full timetable at week 2, with up to 6 week assessment period to ascertain destination:

PATHWAY 1 - quick recovery and returned to mainstream within 1 term

PATHWAY 3 - EHCP names WPES as provision long term and / OR Year 10/11 entry leads to student remaining until end of Key Stage
